He also told this parable to some who trusted in themselves that they

you that I am not like other men, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or

even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week; I give tithes of all that I

get.' But the tax collector, standing far off, would not even lift up his

eyes to heaven, but beat his breast, saying, 'God, be merciful to me, a

sinner!' I tell you, this man went down to his house justified, rather than the other.
